Privacy Policy

We respect your privacy and carefully protect the information you provide to us when using our Website at: www.bbspirits.pl. This policy aims to explain the principles and scope of our processing of your data, as well as present the rights and obligations you are entitled to in this regard.

What data do we process?

We process data that you provide or leave as part of the use of the website www.bbspirits.pl. These are primarily data necessary to establish contact provided as part of the contact form and then to perform the contract for the purchase of goods, as well as data that you leave as part of navigating through the website. our Services, including those that you leave in the so-called cookies.

Who is the data controller?

What are the purposes and legal basis for the processing of your personal data and for what period will it be processed?

The legal basis for processing your data for specific purposes is as follows:

- 1. Contact with Website Users personal data is processed to respond to Users' inquiries submitted via the contact form available on the Website. Basis for processing: Art. 6 section 1 letter f GDPR (processing is necessary for the purposes of legally justified interests pursued by the Data Administrator, which is to answer Users' questions.
- 2. Execution of the contract concluded between the Administrator and the customer as well as handling concluded transactions, including, for example, settlement of payments and shipping of goods, including ensuring the service and implementation of consumer rights, for example under warranty or return of goods, both before and after concluding the sales contract, including through direct contact (telephone, e-mail), The basis for data processing is Art. 6 sections 1 letter b) GDPR necessary to perform the contract to which the Customer is a party. The data will be processed until the contract between the Customer and BB SPIRITS Sp. expires. z o. o., with the proviso that sometimes these data may be processed also after the expiry of this contract, but only if it is permitted or required under applicable law, e.g. processing for statistical or settlement purposes or to pursue claims. Providing personal data is voluntary, but failure to provide data marked as necessary to provide services to you will prevent them from being provided.
- 3. Marketing (including analyzing and profiling data for marketing purposes) regarding third-party products and services. The basis for processing is Art. 6 section 1 letter a) voluntary consent. The data will be processed until consent is withdrawn.

To which recipients will your personal data be transferred?

Your data may be transferred to entities processing personal data on behalf of the administrator, including IT service providers, marketing agencies, etc. - such entities process data based on an agreement with the administrator and only by the administrator's instructions. Your data may also be provided to entities

authorized to obtain them under applicable law, e.g. law enforcement authorities if the authority submits a request on an appropriate legal basis (e.g. for the purposes of ongoing criminal proceedings). The operator uses statistical analysis of website traffic via Google Analytics (Google Inc. based in the USA). The operator does not transfer personal data to the operator of this service, only anonymized information. The service is based on the use of cookies on the user's end device. What are your rights related to the processing of personal data?

You have the following rights in connection with our processing of your personal data:

- 1. the right to access your data, including obtaining a copy of the data,
- 2. the right to request rectification of data

5. the right to limit data processing.

If your data is processed based on consent, you can additionally exercise the following rights:

1. the right to withdraw consent to the extent that they are processed on this basis. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal.

If your data is processed based on consent or as part of the service provided (data is necessary to provide the service), you can additionally exercise the following rights:

1. the right to transfer personal data, i.e. to receive your personal data from the administrator in a structured, commonly used, machine-readable format. You can send this data to another data controller.

Information about "cookies"

The website uses its own cookies for the proper functioning of all its functions. The website also uses third-party cookies to use external analytical, marketing and social media tools. Information collected via these cookies is also processed by providers of external tools.

- 1. List of types of cookies used and content of consents:
- a) Necessary Cookies

Necessary cookies are absolutely essential for the website to function properly. These cookies ensure core functionalities and security features of the website operate anonymously.

b) Google Tools

We use Google Analytics, a tool that allows us to collect, view and analyze statistics related to user activity on our website. The Google Analytics tracking code collects information about your activity on our website, which may be used by Google to build your user profile. In addition, information from Google Analytics may be used in the settings of advertising campaigns conducted using Google Ads. If you don't want this, you can disable Google tools.

- 2. The website uses cookies.
- 3. Cookies (so-called "cookies") are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the Website User's end device and are intended for using the Website's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, their storage time on the end device and a unique number.
- 4. The entity that places cookies on the Website User's end device and obtains access to them is the Website operator.
- 5. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
- a) maintaining the Website user's session (after logging in), thanks to which the user does not have to re-enter the login and password on each subpage of the Website;
- b) implementation of statistical purposes
